record of lodgement and the suggestion or concern is then

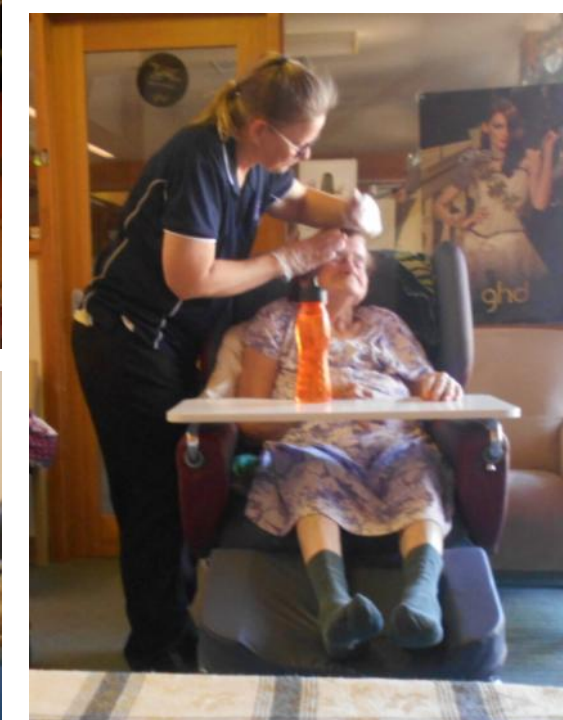
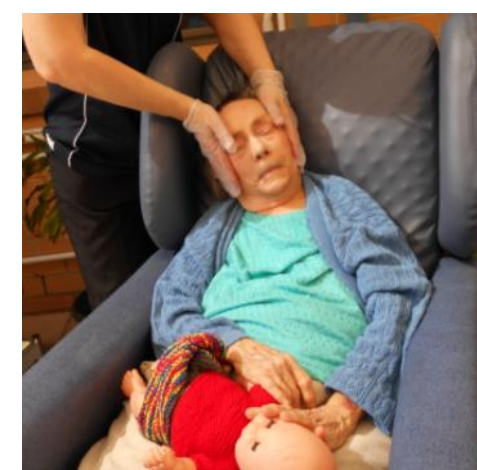

Strawberry Ghosts



Ingredients

2 cups of Strawberries
1 1/2 cups White Chocolate, melted
1tsp Coconut Oil
1/4 cup Mini Choc Chips
1 cup chocolate chips, melted

Method

Step 1

Line a small baking sheet with parchment paper.

Step 2

In a large bowl, combine melted white chocolate and coconut oil and stir until combined.

Dip strawberries into white chocolate and place two mini chocolate chips on the top half of the strawberries for eyes.

Place strawberries on prepared baking sheet and place in the refrigerator to harden, about 10 minutes.

Step 3

Place melted chocolate chips in a ziploc bag and pipe mouths on the strawberries.

Step 4

Let cool again in the refrigerator, 5 minutes. Serve

We look forward to having the Pampurr room which will be later on during the month, Cooking with Rose and a cafe visit at the end of the month!

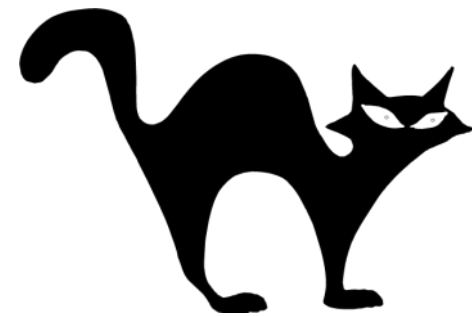

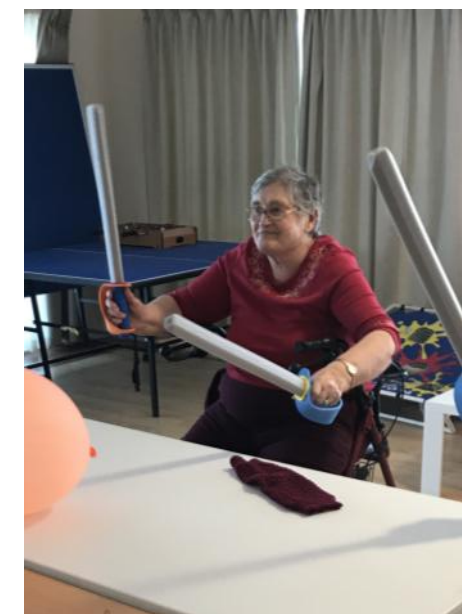

1920: Ellen Street in the early 20th century was dominated by the old Town Hall and Barrier Hotel, both buildings which have since been torn down.

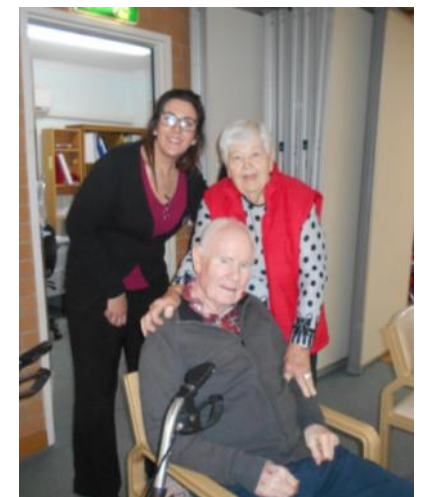


1934: Locals line up along the banks of The Terrace, at the corner of York Road, during the worst flood in the city's history.
