



Smoked Salmon on Dill Pikelets

Ingredients

Pikelets:

- 1/2 cup self-raising flour
- 1 egg yolk
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 1/2 tbs fresh dill

Topping:

- 2/3 cup mascarpone
- 2 tsp wholegrain mustard

To Serve:

- 80 g smoked salmon sliced
- 1 tbs fresh dill

Method

Step 1: Sift flour into bowl and gradually whisk in combined egg yolk, milk and dill.

Step 2: Whisk until smooth, Drop teaspoons of mixture into greased pan and cook until bubbles appear.

Step 3: Turn pikelets, brown on other side and cool on wire rack.

Step 4: Make topping. Combine cheese and mustard and mix well

Step 5: Spoon topping over pikelets, add salmon and fresh dill.

Just for Laughs






An Afternoon in the Park
