UNDERSTANDING THE PAYMENT OPTIONS

Residents can choose to pay either a RAD (refundable accommodation deposit), a DAP (daily accommodation payment) or a combination of both. A RAD is paid as a lump sum when you enter the facility, or a DAP accrues daily and is paid monthly.

Price excludes daily care charges approximately of a single pension means tested care fees.

*A Combination Assets and Income Assessment form (SA457) will need to be completed to determine asset levels of the resident and if they meet the requirements of a supported resident. A supported resident will have their accommodation costs paid in full or part by the Australian Government. Excludes Daily Care Fee
